### Dothraki Jewellery Workshop

The most oversubscribed item on last year's programme was the Dothraki Jewellery Workshop run by Emma Andrews from the *Game of Thrones* Drapes and Embroidery department. So of course we've brought it back again this year with two workshops for 12 people each to get the opportunity to create their own Dothraki jewellery. All the material is provided including real horse hair from Emma's own horses.

### Valyrian Sculpture Workshop

Talented artists Ric and Robin will be demonstrating how to sculpt beautiful Valyrian style sculptures using milliput. Try your hand at crafting your own dragon sculpture which you can take home with you.

### Iron Bank of Braavos Coin Bag Workshop

New for 2013 Emma Andrews will be walking 12 lucky people through the process of crafting their very own leather coin bag. It doesn't have to be in the style of the Iron Bank of Braavos, you could craft it in a style suitable for Littlefinger or the Hand of the King or your favourite House. ### Medieval Crafts: Tablet Weaving
